Learning objectives: Morphology, anatomy, occlusion of the molars - occlusion surface, function and gnathology

Course outline:

During the course we will not only learn how the molars look like but why what they are.

We will understand the 2 and 3 point's occlusion;

We will get to know the occlusion compass and its importance.

Helping with these knowledge's we will get a complex picture of the context between shape and function.

In the practical part of the course we will shape the upper and lower molars (4; 5; 6) from wax on models.

The benefit of these 3 days will be not only nicer molars but better function.

We will be able to grind the occlusion surface of the restorations faster and more effective in accordance with the criteria of function and gnathology.

Acquisition of this knowledge can help by the processes of the removable and fixed Prosthodontics , restoratives and also Orthodontics.
